Mandatory accident reporting

Whereas, Gordon Krofchick was hit by a car when he was cycling home on a November 2013 evening on County Road 7 north of Guelph; and

Whereas, the driver of the car didn't report the collision to police as she believed she had hit an animal; and

Whereas, Mr. Krofchick's body was not found until the following morning on the side of the road; and

Whereas, when authorities are notified in a timely fashion, they have the opportunity to investigate, respond and treat potential injuries to accident victims; and

Whereas, there is no requirement for drivers to report collisions with animals resulting in less than \$1,000 damage

We, the undersigned, petition the legislative assembly of Ontario to review and amend the Highway Traffic Act to require drivers to stop their vehicles and report to the police following any and all collisions.
